MTA 2011 "Take the Car or \$10K Cash" Promotion

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Promoter is MTA More Than Accountants Pty Ltd, ABN 69 137 775 located at 1917 Logan Road, Upper Mt Gravatt, QLD, 4122, Australia.
2. Information on how to enter, all promotional material and the Prize form part of these Conditions of Entry. Entry into the MTA "Take the Car or \$10K" promotion is deemed to be acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Competition commences at 12.01am (AEST) on 01/07/2011. Entries close at 4.59pm (AEST) on 30th April 2012.
4. The winner will be drawn at the 'MTA Open Day 2012' at the head office of MTA More Than Accountants at 1917 Logan Road, Upper Mt Gravatt, QLD, 4122, Australia at a date to be selected.
5. Employees and immediate family members of the Promoter, agencies or companies associated with the Competition, are ineligible to enter. "Immediate family members" means spouses, parents, children or siblings, whether or not they live in the same house as the employee.
6. The approximate total prize pool is valued at \$25,000.00. A car valued at up to \$15,000 or \$10,000 cash. There is one prize to be won, to be selected by the overall winner.

How to enter

1. Have MTA complete and lodge your tax return (at their Upper Mount Gravatt Head office, Garden City office, Aspley office, Victoria Point office, MTA Tax Booths or by an MTA Mobile Tax Consultant) by the competition closure date to receive an eligible entry into this promotion.
2. Every month from July 2011 to April 2012 there will be a Golden Key draw. There are 100 x Golden Keys to win. One of these Golden Keys will open the car at the MTA Open Day in 2012. Winners of Golden Keys will be notified by telephone and by correspondence. If a client cannot be reached after numerous attempts, a Golden Key redraw will take place. Any client who wins a Golden Key must be present at the MTA Open Day in 2012 to win the major prize. If a Golden Key winner is unable to attend, a friend or family member can be present in their place. Golden Keys will be handed out according to registration order at the MTA Open Day in 2012 based on 1 - 100. Golden Key redraws will occur if a client cannot initially be contacted or has not provided a final RSVP for the MTA Open Day in 2012.
3. The MTA 'Take the Car or \$10K' competition is a Category 4 promotion as per the *Charitable and Non-Profit Gaming Act 1999*.
4. Category 4 promotional games are free entry draws conducted to promote goods or services. Any person may conduct a promotional game. They are normally conducted by businesses to promote the sale of products. How winners will be determined

2. The winner of the car can decide if they will retain the car as the prize or select \$10,000 AUD as the alternative. Only one prize can be selected by the winner.
